Lorren worked on several ranches in the surrounding area including: Interior, SD, Montana, Wyoming, and for the New Moon Trailer Company in Rapid City. He also

worked on the missile bases. His ambition all his life was to be a good cowboy. He also served in the US Army.

He accepted Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior and that became the most important thing in his life.

In 1950, he married Lorraine Moore and in 1957, a son, Lance, was born. Upon his fathers' death, they returned to the ranch to operate it. In 1977, Lorraine was killed in an automobile accident.

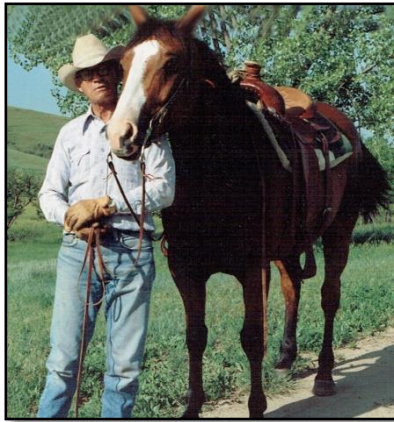
