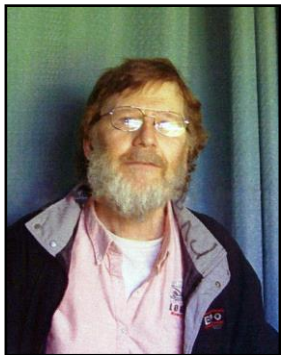


David Clifton Shepherd

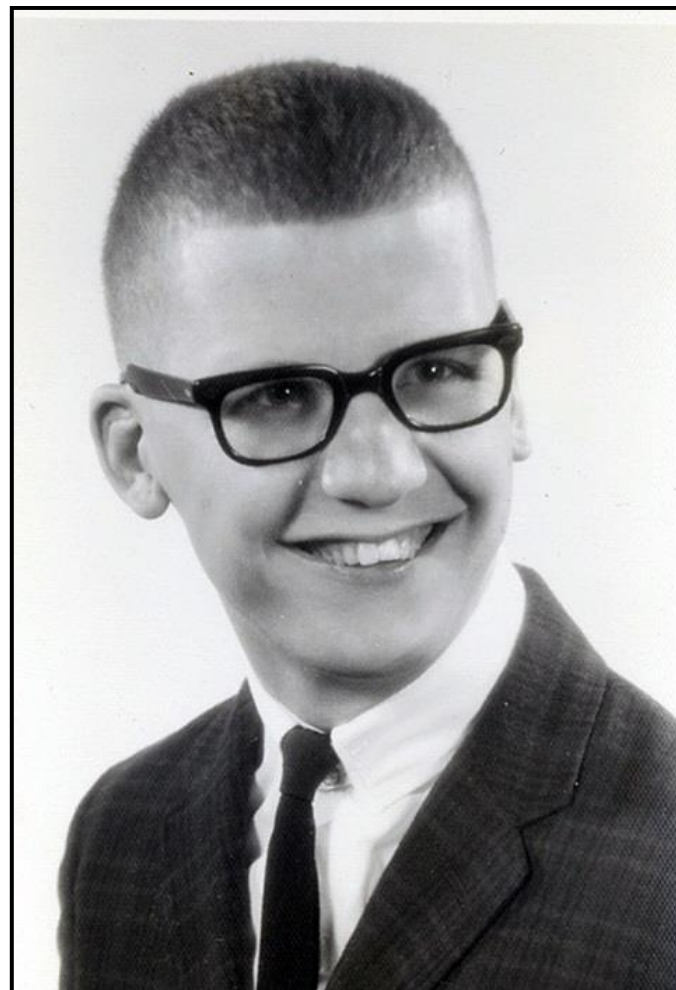
