degree.

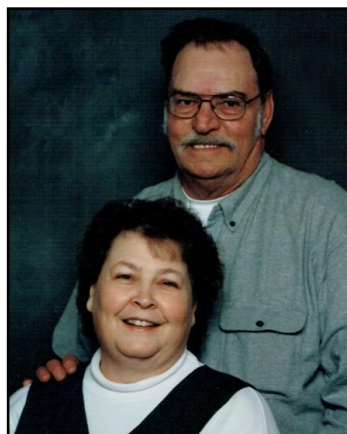

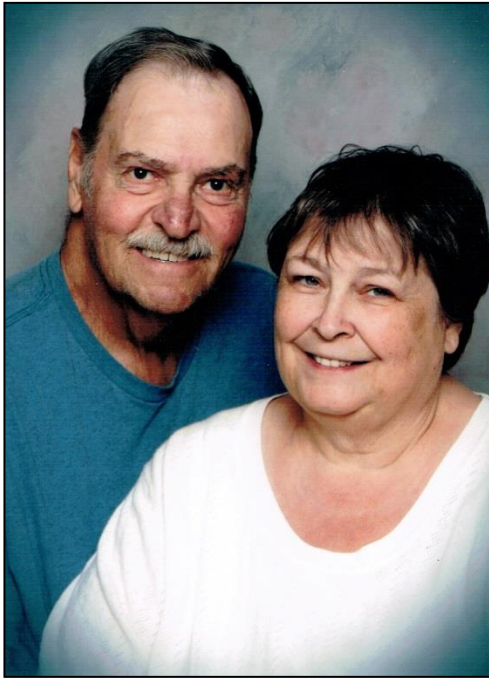
