Memorials have been established to West Winds Home Health and Hospice, the Prairie Bible Church, and the Rural Meade County Ambulance.

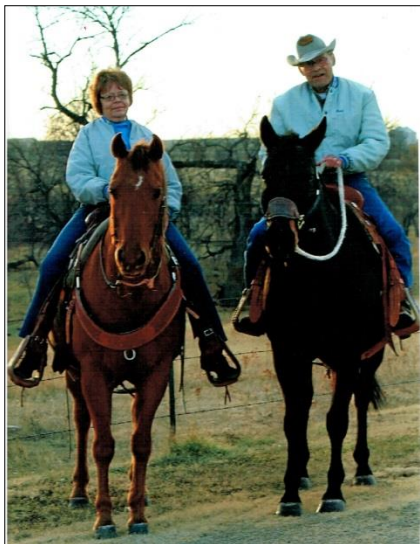
